WEST MAUI AND KONA**

**HONOLULU** – This summer, Island Air began offering daily flights between Kapalua and Kona and an additional early evening flight between Kahului and Kona. The new flights were added to accommodate the increase in summer travel and will be offered through September 5, 2005.

“These flights are great news for visitors and residents who want more options when flying between Maui and the Big Island,” said Island Air CEO Robert Mauracher. “The flights will save our customers time and money.”

Mauracher noted that the Kapalua to Kona flight was added to support West Maui’s popular tourist destinations — Lahaina, Kaanapali and Kapalua. The Kahului-Kona flights depart Kona at 5 p.m. and Kahului at 6 p.m., enabling travelers to spend more time on each island.

The lowest one-way airfare between Maui (Kapalua and Kahului) and Kona is \$89.10.
